Our mission is our common goal

We love and equip people to discover their own strengths! That's our mission and it is

quite an ambitious statement to make! It means that we are not just an aid organisation, but also dedicated to helping people deal with their challenging lives.

After initial preparations we chose the *Kingdom of Lesotho in southern Africa* as the home base of our project, because it promised vast opportunities for efficient work on location.

Our concern

We look at our work in Lesotho as something like "searching and finding", based on the most motivating forces, to strengthen families and communities and to work together to find and create solutions. A "push of energy" to become active and take ownership can be very helpful, provided that something specific is implemented. Only then can something be truly created on one's own initiative.

Our activities will be directed at gardening (planting and cultivation of trees), good nutrition (guaranteeing basic supplies), good health (guaranteeing basic medical care and its application), further training and coaching (staff and caregivers on: self-empowerment and its impact on the community) and volunteer programmes. However, a special emphasis will be placed on encouraging people to assume responsibility for their lives and show initiative.

Our first program

Since April 2014 we have been supporting the community-based organisation Phelisanong (pronounced: Phe-di-sah-nahng) near Pitseng in North-Western Lesotho. Currently 325 people live in Phelisanong, amongst them 138 orphans and adolescents. 50 children and adolescents are physically or mentally handicapped. In addition to that many children are HIV positive.

The community owns 5 typical earth building style huts (Basotho huts), a school, a garden centre and a medical facility. Phelisanong was initiated in 2002 by Mamello Mokholokoe (founder) and her members.
